Mrs. Charlotte B. Newman of San Diego, California, passed away June 20, 1921, at the age of 93 years, 9 months and 23 days, after an illness of nearly six months.

She was born in South Strafford, Vermont, August 29, 1827, was married to Asahel C. Newman December 22, 1851. Moved from Vermont to Newton, Iowa, in 1856, and to Grinnell in 1863, where she continued to reside, living in the Park street home for 30 years, until 1902. Her husband died in 1900. She has lived in San Diego 19 years, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Geo. F. Mahler. Her son, Dr. W. H. Newman, is living at Long Beach, Calif. a sister, Mrs. Finnerte S. Kendall, at Chula Vista, a brother, S. S. Preston, in Los Angeles.

Hers was a very busy and useful life. She has helped many college students during their struggles for an education in Grinnell, and has been a blessing in her family and neighborhood, as a woman of fine Christian character, having many warm friends.

The funeral services were conducted by Dr. E. F. Hallenbeck of the First Presbyterian church, June 21, 1921, at 2 p. m., in the chapel of the Greenwood Crematory. Two of her favorite songs were sung, "My Soul Be on Thy Guard" and "Jesus Lover of My Soul."
