Frances J. Newman, 65, died of respiratory failure Monday, Aug. 5, at Walter Boswell Memorial Hospital, Sun City, Ariz.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Aug. 10, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Colo, with the Rev. Father John Herzog officiating. Burial was at Calvary Cemetery in Brooklyn, with the Rev. Father Anthony Farrell officiating.
