## Last Rites Said For Mr. Nicholson

Jesse J. Nicholson, 63, Malcom, died Saturday morning, Dec. 7, 1968 at Grinnell General Hospital, East. He had been in failing health the past 20 years and was hospitalized a month ago.

The son of James and Lillie Tuller Nicholson, Mr. Nicholson was born on June 11, 1905 near Leon, Iowa. He attended the local schools near his home and later enlisted in the United States Navy, serving as a cook for three years.

Following his discharge, Mr.

Nicholson worked as a painter and carpenter, and railroad cook. His health began to fail him early in life and he has lived in semi-retirement at Malcom since 1943.

On Dec. 5, 1938, Mr. Nicholson was married in Grinnell to Daisy Smith, who survives him at their Malcom home.

Others surviving include six sisters—Mrs. Delbert (Adria) Webster of Des Moines, Mrs. Harold (Faye) Stubbs of Choctaw, Okla., Mrs. Bert (Cleo) Gwinn of Fontana, Calif., Mrs. Doyle (Betty) Dale of Decatur, Iowa, and Mrs. Dean (Nadine) Turner and Mrs. Luther (Mavis) Luppe, both of National City, Calif.; two aunts—Mrs. Frank Sinclair of Indianola, and Mrs. Haddy Tuller of Leon, and a number of nieces and nephews and cousins.

Funeral services for Jesse J. Nicholson were held at 2 p.m. today, Monday, Dec. 9, at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. James Davidson, minister of the Malcom Methodist Church, officiating.

Burial was in Ivy Hill Cemetery at Malcom.
