Kenneth L. Norris, 69,
Oskaloosa, formerly of
Grinnell, died Tuesday, Dec.
10, at Mahaska County
Hospital, Oskaloosa, of a
heart attack.

Funeral services were held
Thursday, Dec. 12, at Bates
Funeral Chapel, Oskaloosa,
with Pastor Alvern Boetsma
of Good News Chapel,
Oskaloosa, officiating. Burial
was in Forest Cemetery,
Oskaloosa.
