
Sarah Norton *7-12* *7-10* *1931* Dies Suddenly

Miss Sarah Downie Norton, aged 70, of 1916 Fifth avenue, was found dead at her home this morning about 10:30 by Mrs. George Ziegenmeyer. Miss Norton was an old time resident of Grinnell.

She was last seen alive picking berries Wednesday evening in her yard by Mrs. Arthur Lincoln. This morning Mrs. Ziegenmeyer went to Miss Norton's home at the request of Mrs. John Goodfellow, for whom Miss Norton was to have worked Thursday.

Upon finding Miss Norton dead, Mrs. Ziegenmeyer called Dr. Bower, who summoned Dale Smith, coroner. According to them Miss Norton had been dead at least thirty hours.

Relatives were notified immediately and Mrs. William Norton, sister-in-law and daughter, Mrs. Ray Norton of Des Moines, will arrive here this evening to make funeral arrangements. Miss Norton also leaves a son, her brother who is now in Cedar Rapids, and a sister-in-law, Mrs. E. E. Norton, of Seattle, Wash.
