Donald R. Ogg, 74, of Kellogg died Wednesday, Feb. 19, at Skiff Medical Center in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the Kellogg United Methodist Church, with the Rev. William Long officiating. Burial was in Newton Union Cemetery.
