Lenore Marie Ohland, 90, of Grinnell died Friday, July 26, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at Trinity Lutheran Church, with the Rev. Herb Knudten Jr. officiating. Organist was Teresa Ziegenmeyer, and pallbearers were Mark, Vince and Leon Sandersfeld, Don Hale, Dennis Dimmer, Tim Reihmann and Dennis Kleinmeyer. Burial was in Ivy Hill Cemetery, with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Jonathon Landford and Bertha Josphina Wehausen Hockett, she was born Dec. 25, 1905, in Manitowoc, Wis. She moved with her family to Grinnell in 1907 where she was raised and received her education. She was a graduate of Grinnell High School and received her nursing degree from Grinnell Community Hospital in 1928.

She was married to John C. Ohland Jan. 27, 1932, in Geneseo, Ill., and they lived in Grinnell. Mrs. Ohland had an active nursing career, both in a hospital setting and as a private nurse. During World War II, she taught Red Cross and first aid in Sheridan Township. She lived in Iowa County from 1948 to 1956, then returned to Grinnell.

She worked for several years at Grinnell Community Hospital and later for Dr. John Parish. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, the Altar Guild and Ladies Aid, the Veterans of World War I Auxiliary and M.A.C. Choir.

Surviving are two children, Paul of Ft. Collins, Colo., and Helen Sandersfeld of Williamsburg; one sister, Myrtle Gilbert of Grinnell; one brother, Howard Hockett of Guttenberg; nine grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; one sister, Bernice Sickinger; and one brother, Norman Hockett.
