Robert N. Olberding, 58, of 1812 West St., Grinnell, died of cancer Wednesday, May 20, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

The Funeral Mass will be celebrated at 3:30 p.m. Saturday at St. Francis Xavier Basilica in Dyersville, with the Rev. Stanley Hayteck officiating. Burial will be in St. Francis Cemetery, Dyersville.

Graveside rites will be conducted by the Dyersville American Legion Post.
