

Gifford Olson *H-72 March 3, 1980* services held

Gifford J. Olson, 63, died Thursday evening at his home at Holiday Lake. *F&B*

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn, with the Rev. Dan Driscoll of the Baptist Church of Brooklyn officiating. Cremation is set for today in Cedar Rapids.

The son of Ole and Bertha Sexe Olson, he was born March 14, 1916, in Des Moines. He was a veteran of World War II, serving from 1942 to 1945. Mr. Olson was married to Faye Angsted in Des Moines.
