Funeral services were held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn for Mrs. Nellie M. Olson, 79, of Rte. 1, Malcom, who died Sunday morning in Mercy Hospital in Des Moines of a heart condition. She had been a patient at the hospital since July 13.

The Rev. E. C. Elzey, pastor of the Trinity Lutheran Church in rural Malcom, and the Rev. John Maze, pastor of the Malcom-Sheridan Parish in Malcom, officiated at the services.
