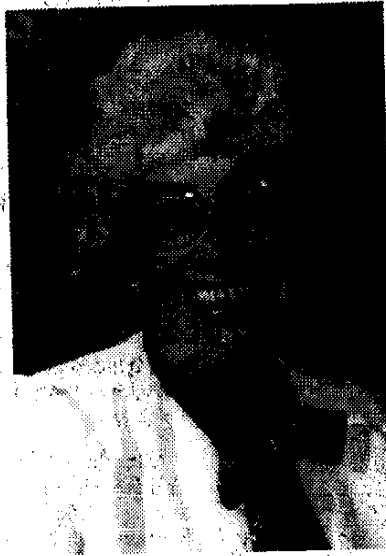


Harriett Onthank



Harriett Onthank, 80, of Grinnell died at her home Sunday, June 30.

Graveside services were conducted Wednesday at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. Ken Wallace, pastor of the Newburg Congregational Church, officiating.

She was born Feb. 23, 1922, in Grinnell to Sherley and Ida Miller Eichhorn. She was raised in Grinnell and was a graduate of Grinnell High School. She worked for various Grinnell businesses following her education.

On Feb. 28, 1942, she was married to Marion P. Onthank in Santa Monica, Calif. She lived in California while Mr. Onthank served with the U.S. Navy during World War II.

The couple moved to Grinnell in 1947 and established Onthank Body and Fender Co. Mrs. Onthank was president of the business and worked as the company's bookkeeper until her health failed a few months ago.

She was a member of the Grinnell United Methodist Church and the VFW Auxiliary. She also had volunteered at the former St. Francis Hospital.

Surviving are a son, Jim of Grinnell; three grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one brother, Jack Eichhorn.
