## Death Claims Former Resident

MS Neda Pearl Palmer, 85, a former Grinnell resident, died April 8 in Long Beach, Calif.

Born March 18, 1884 in Chester Center, she was the daughter of George A. and Louella Palmer. She graduated from Grinnell High School in 1902, attended Grinnell College for two years, and then took a teaching position in a country school near Grinnell. She taught at Davis School for some years, and graduated from the University of Iowa in 1912. Teaching in Marengo and Fort Dodge was followed by a short period of teaching at the State Normal School in Nebraska. She retired to Long Beach in 1949.

Neda Pearl Palmer is survived by her sister, Louella of Long Beach, and two brothers, Alfred of Earlham, Ia., and Herbert of Waterloo. She was preceded in death by her father and mother and three sisters, Alice, Stella, and Eleanor.
