Wanda L. Anderson Parsons, 72, of Whitefish Bay, Wis., formerly of the Kellogg area, died Sunday, Aug. 10, at Froedert Memorial Lutheran Hospital in Wauwatosa, Wis., of injuries she sustained in an automobile accident.
