Services held for Mrs. Paul

Mrs. Ann E. Paul, 59, of Gilman died Friday evening, Oct. 16, at her home.

Funeral services for Ann E. Paul were held at 1:30 p.m. Monday, Oct. 19, in the Gilman United Church of Christ, with the Rev. Jerry Cassidy officiating.

Burial was at Prairie View Cemetery.

Born Aug. 2, 1922, in Ballymena County, Antrim, North Ireland, she was the daughter of Alexander and Elizabeth Stewart. She was raised and educated in Northern Ireland and graduated from the Royal Victoria School of Nursing.

She spent two years as a nurse in Ontario and British

Columbia, Canada, and afterwards moved to the United States.

She married David A. Paul on May 7, 1972, in Grinnell, and became a citizen of the United States in March of 1980. She was a member of the Gilman United Church of Christ, the Tuesday Progress Club, the Birthday Club, the Entre Nous Club and the Britannia Club. She also supported Friends of the Gilman Library.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband.

Surviving her are a stepdaughter, Judith Falcone of Philadelphia, Pa.; and three sisters and two brothers still living in Northern Ireland.
