Eliza Paul was born in County Antrim, Ireland, Feb. 21, 1827 and departed this life Jan. 9, 1907.

She was married to Robert Paul of Tesbreen County Antrim, Ireland, Nov. 13, 1844. They emigrated to Scott Co., Iowa, in 1863. In 1872 they came to Jasper County and she has resided in Hickory Grove township ever since.

She was the mother of four children: two preceded her to the Great-Beyond. One son, J. R. Paul, and one daughter, Mrs. James Lowry of Gilman, survive her: also three brothers. James Paul of County Antrim, Ireland. Wm. Paul of Gilman and David Paul of Newton, and
