Lawrence Paul dies at 67

Lawrence E. Paul, 67, died Friday, May 17, at Merced, Calif.

Following cremation, his ashes were scattered at sea. The family requests that any memorials be directed to the American Cancer Society.

Mr. Paul was born Jan. 27, 1918, in Gilman. He graduated from Gilman High School in 1934. During World War II he served with the U.S. Air Force.
