

## Robert H. Paulson

Robert H. "Bob" Paulson, 82, of Newton, formerly of Kellogg, died of a heart attack Wednesday, Sept. 20, at Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the Kellogg Christian Church, with the Rev. Mike Johnson officiating. Interment was in Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg, with the Wallace Family Funeral Home of Newton in charge of arrangements.
