

## Services Held At Victor For Mrs. A. Pawlak

Funeral services for Mrs. Anton (Augusta) Pawlak, Sr., 68, Victor, were held Dec. 17th at St. James Lutheran church in Victor. Mrs. Pawlak died Dec. 15th at a Grinnell hospital.
