

## Rites held for James Peak III

James Peak III, 74 formerly of Grinnell, died Saturday, Sept. 1, at a Liberty, Tex., hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Sept. 3 at the Allison Memorial Chapel in Liberty, with the Rev. Jesse Roberson officiating. Burial was at Fairlawn Memorial Cemetery in Liberty.
