

PETER PEDERSON.

Peter Pederson, as stated in Friday's Herald, died at the home of his son near town last Thursday at the age of 54 years, 9 months and 13 days. The deceased was born in Haugesund, Norway, and emigrated to this country in 1891. He came of the hardy religious Scandinavian stock that has done so much for this country, and was an active supporter of the local Lutheran church. His wife died five years ago. He leaves five children, all of whom were present at his funeral, which was held Saturday. It was conducted from the house at one o'clock and at the Lutheran church at 2 o'clock. Services were in charge of his pastor, Rev. S. M. Stenby, with a sermon also in English by Rev. B. L. Opdahl. Bearers were E. Erikson, I. Iverson, T. Carlstrom, T. Olsen, J. Syalland and C. Peterson.

The deceased was of a strong character, of a deep religious nature and leaves the inheritance to his children of an upright life. *July 14, 1910*
