Mrs. Perry Funeral Held Wednesday

Funeral services for Mrs. Kenneth Perry were conducted at 11 a.m. Wednesday, August 10, by the Rev. Howard Hayes at the Methodist Church in Montezuma. William Rempp was soloist at the services accompanied by Miss Alice Underwood, organist.

Interment was in Jackson Township Cemetery. Casket bearers were Roy Baird, Basil Hicks, Phillip Grier, Clayton Dee, Lauren James and James Means.

Mrs. Perry, 43, died Saturday, August 6, at her home in Montezuma.

Born May 6, 1923, in Oskaloosa, Evaleen Perry was the daughter of William and Gladys Perry. She attended an Oskaloosa elementary school and graduated from Oskaloosa High School in 1941.

She was employed as a

bookkeeper for a department store in Oskaloosa until her marriage to Kenneth Perry on Aug. 8, 1944.

Mr. and Mrs. Perry lived in Oskaloosa for several years and then moved to Grinnell. In 1953 they moved to Montezuma where her husband became a partner in the Perry Implement Co. and Mrs. Perry served as the firm's bookkeeper.

She was a member of the Montezuma Methodist Church and served as a member of the Montezuma Public Library board of trustees.

She is survived by her husband and their two sons, Michael and James; her mother, Mrs. Gladys Perry, a sister, Mrs. Marion Scoles, both of Petaluma, Calif.; and a brother, William of San Francisco.
