Mrs. Martin Peterson Of 1935 Kellogg Dies

They first located in Illinois and later came to Kellogg, where they have resided, and also at Malcom and Latimer.

Three children were born of this mion, two of whom survive. She was a member of the Lutheran murch, having been confirmed in that faith in Denmark in early shildhood.

Surviving relatives include her usband, a daughter, Mrs. Garrett Poortinger of Osceola, a son. Louie Peterson of this place, and a brother, Andrew Anderson, also of this place.
