Mrs. Martin Peterson Of Kellogg Dies

Kellogg, Ia., Sept. 8, Special:

Mrs. Martin Peterson died at her home here Friday evening, August 25, following a paralytic stroke suffered Sunday. She had been in failing health for some time.

Bertha Anderson was born in Tiested, Denmark June 18, 1864, and grew to womanhood there. She was united in marriage to Martin Peterson March 9, 1884, and three days later they sailed for the United States to make their home. They first located in Illinois and later came to Kellogg, where they have resided, and also at Malcom and Latimer.

Three children were born of this union, two of whom survive. She was a member of the Lutheran church, having been confirmed in that faith in Denmark in early childhood.

Surviving relatives include her husband, a daughter, Mrs. Garrett Boortinger of Osceola, a son, Louie Peterson of this place, and a brother, Andrew Anderson, also of this place.

Funeral services were held at the home Sunday afternoon and burial was made in the family lot in Our Silent City.
