

## Services For Mrs. Ellen Peterson, Conducted Friday,

Funeral services for Mrs. E. W. T. (Ellen) Peterson were held at 2 p.m. Friday, August 12, at the Methodist Church in Montezuma. The Rev. Howard Hayes conducted the services.

Mrs. Peterson, 33, died at St. Francis Hospital, Grinnell, on Tuesday, August 9.

Ellen Matilda Peterson was the daughter of Mary and John Wickland. She was born at Lehrville, Iowa, on Nov. 13, 1830. She attended a rural school in Calhoun County and at the age of 14 she was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith at the Skaraborg Church at Piper, Iowa. For a short time she worked in Des Moines.

On Dec. 29, 1898, she married Ernest Wm. Theodore Peterson and to this union six children were born. They lived on a farm near Lehr-
