Funeral Services Here Today For Roy A. Pettingill

Roy A. Pettingill, 70, resident of the Morrison Home, here, died here early Tuesday morning. He had made his home here for the last two years.

Previously, he had resided in Grinnell where he had been employed as a glove cutter at the Morrison-Shultz glove factory.

Funeral services were held this afternoon Thursday from the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Ralph Beebe of the Marflower Home officiating. Organ music was provided by Mrs. Kathleen Hermer.

Serving as pallbearers were Wesley Ahrens, Russ Orbeck, Walter Warner, Jim McNally, Eldon Olds and Ellis Brown. Interment was in Hawthood cemetery.

Born July 18th, 1892, at Riverville, N. Y., he was the son of Byron and Frances Helen Pettingill. He attended the Riverville area schools and in Sept. 1911, 1917, was under 18 months with Helen Schmal, Wanda W. McIngonia, Iowa.

To this union was born one son, Charles Byron Pettingill, presently of Marshalltown. In addition to his son, he is survived by two grandchildren, Charles E. Pettingill of Waukon and Jack E. Pettingill of Riverdale. Carl, Alex, Raymond and seven great grandchildren and one sister, Mrs. Earl Dyer of Glenwood, N. Y.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Hilda, in 1959, and two brothers, Bert and Isaac Pettingill.

Mr. Pettingill had lived in Grinnell for 50 years, having moved here from New York State. He was a member of the Congregational Church.
