Last Rites Said For Nellie Pfund

Funeral services were held at 10 a.m. today (Monday, Nov. 10) at the James Semanske Funeral Home for Nellie C. Pfund, 94, of Route 1, Malcom, who died Thursday evening at the Brookhaven Nursing Home following an extended illness.

The Rev. Basil Grimes of Des Moines officiated at the services. Organist was Mrs. Kathleen Hoffer. Honorary pallbearers were J. A. Bissel, Clarence Muzzemannier, David Schultz, Jack Marcus, John P. Stewart, Edward Muzzemannier, Stephen A. Stewart and John A. Schmucker.

Vocalist was Raymond Casper. Burial was in Evergreen Cemetery at Jewell.

The daughter of John D. and Elizabeth Sparr Young, Mrs. Pfund was born March 13, 1875, at Clinton, Iowa. She joined the German Evangelical Church as a young girl and was an active member of the First Evangelical Church of Des Moines from 1923 to 1956.

After 1956, Mrs. Pfund made her home with her daughter Mrs. Elizabeth Schultz who lives in the Malcom community. Following an illness in May of 1967, she had made her home at the Brookhaven Nursing Home in Brooklyn.

On June 15, 1904, Mrs. Pfund was married to Carl A. Pfund at Clinton, Iowa.

Survivors include her four children - Mrs. S. O. (Ruth) Armistead of Jacksonville, Fla., Mrs. Ervin (Elizabeth) Schultz of Malcom, Mrs. Cari (Myrtle) Schmacker of Des Moines, and Charles E. Pfund of West Newton, Mass.; 10 grandchildren, and 11 great grandchildren.

Mrs. Pfund was preceded in death by her husband on Feb. 5, 1953; her parents, all of her brothers and sisters, and an infant son, John Adam, in December of 1909.
