Clifford M. Phipps, son of John and Sarah Phipps, was born Mar. 28, 1887, in Jasper county. After a lingering illness of 3 1/2 years in the Iowa Soldiers Home, Marshalltown, he was taken to the Veterans hospital in Des Moines, where he suddenly passed away September 19, 1958, at the age of 71 years, 3 months, and 22 days.

In 1910 he was united in marriage to Minnie Gilbert at Okmaloosa, Iowa. To this union were born eight children. He spent most of his life in Rock Creek township, moving to Geneseo in 1939.

Preceding him in death were his wife and two children, and one grandchild.

He was associated with the Primitive Baptist church.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. R. C. Pauline Turner of Munroe, Iowa; sons—Don, Raymond, Hilda, and Paul of Hammond, and Elmer of Tama; a sister, Nora Phipps of Keosauqua; six grandchildren, two nephews, and many friends.
