OBITUARY

NORA ELLEN PHIPPS

Nora Ellen Phipps was born Mar. 27, 1886 in Rock Creek Township, Jasper County, Iowa, the daughter of John L. and Sarah Phipps.

She died Monday, July 5th, 1965, at her home in Kellogg at the age of 79. She had not been in the best of health for several months.

She attended the local rural schools near her home and later, in 1915, moved with her parents to the family home in Kellogg. There she helped care for her parents and was also employed with the Midwest Metal Stamping Company for 22 years.

Miss Phipps attended the Primitive Baptist church.

The last member of her immediate family, she was preceded in death by her parents; one sister, Ada Belle Phipps who died in 1914; and two brothers, Wade Phipps in 1927 and Clifford Phipps in 1958.

Surviving are a niece, Mrs. Roy (Pauline) Turner of Muncie, Ind.; and several nephews, Glen H. Phipps, Bert L. Phipps, Dale L. Phipps, Clyde J. Phipps, Raymond W. Phipps, Don Phipps and Hollis Phipps, all of the Grinnell area, and Richard Kenneth Shaw of Toledo.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Friday, July 9th, from the Smith Funeral Home with the Elder Fred Phipps of the Primitive Baptist church officiating. Vocal music was provided by Mrs. Noel Taylor and pallbearers were Earl Lemke, Floyd Miller, James Roth, Lloyd Hurdle, Dale Brater and Bill Cooper.

Interment was in Rock Creek Township cemetery.
