## Maxine Walker Pidima BC Nov. 24, 1999

A graveside service was held at 4 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 21, at the Guernsey Cemetery at Guernsey for Maxine Pidima, 86, who died Saturday, Nov. 13, 1999, in the Hiawatha Care Center in Hiawatha. The Rev. Torger Johnson of the Guernsey Methodist Church officiated.

She was a member of the Guernsey Methodist Church and was a Sunday school teacher and the church pianist for many years.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Lawrence, and one daughter, Jo Ann Schutterle. Survivors include one daughter, Janie Stutler of Robins, and two grandchildren, L.E. Stutler and Melanne Miller.
