Carrie Pilgrim, 81, Grinnell, died at a local hospital Thursday afternoon following a lingering illness.

Funeral services were held Saturday at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. Leland Mann officiating. Soloist was Mrs. Dolph Miller and organist was Mrs. Kathleen Hefner.
