Mrs. Evangeline Plum Dies In Ames, Iowa

Mrs. Evangeline C. Plum, 70, died Sunday morning at the Mary Greeley Hospital at Ames, Iowa, following an illness of the past three years.

The daughter of George and Mary Burr Slater, she was born May 1, 1897 at Anita, Iowa. On June 7, 1917 she was united in marriage with Fred LeRoy, who preceded her in death on Sept. 26, 1918.

On June 4, 1926 she was united in marriage with Robert L. Plum, who preceded her in death on Feb. 28, 1957. To this union two sons were born Robert Eugene Plum of Lincoln, Neb., and Glen Edward Plum of Ames, Iowa.

For the past nine months she has made her home with her son Glen in Ames, Iowa. Previous to this her home was at 1825 6th Ave. in Grinnell.

Mrs. Plum was a member of the Grinnell Methodist Church and the Pythian Sisters.

Besides her two sons, she is also survived by four granddaughters, and her brother Harold Slater of Newton, Iowa. She was also preceded in death by three brothers and three sisters.

Funeral services for Mrs. Plum will be held Tuesday at 2 p.m. at the James - Schalinske Funeral Home.

The Rev. Chester E. Custer, pastor of the Grinnell Methodist church, will officiate and burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery.
