Loving Longmore was born in Turnbull county, Ohio, August 18, 1832. While a resident of Indiana in 1857, she was united in marriage with Wm. T. Prather. In 1879 they moved to Grinnell, and here has been the home since. About fifteen years ago Mrs. Prather became a member of the M. E. church and has lived a christian life consistent with auch membership. Her husband preceded her to the spirit land last January. Mrs. Prather's death occurred Thursday, Oct. 20, after an illness of two months. The funeral was held Saturday at ten o'clock, conducted by Rev. D. F. Stiles of Ewart, her own pastor being absent from town. The funeral decorations were beautiful, including tokens of sympathy and esteem from the Daughters of Rebekah and the Relief Corps. It is the testimony of those who knew Mrs. Prather that a good woman has gone to her heavenly reward. Five children survive her, George, now of Iowa City, Albert, Charles, Della and Mrs. Cora Wells.
