Dies After An Illness of a Week From Heart Trouble at Home at 923 West Street

WAS FATHER OF DAWSON PUGH WHO DIED AT CAMP CODY, 1918.

Funeral Services To Be Held Tomorrow Morning at 10:30 from Home.

William Grant Pugh was born in West Virginia on June 5, 1864 and passed away Wednesday evening, Feb. 13, at 9:00 o'clock of heart trouble after an illness of about a week.
