

—Clinton Augustus Rand was born December 31, 1846, at Townshend, Vermont. He lived in Troy, N Y; Allen's Grove, Wisconsin; Brookfield, Missouri, and spent the last half of his life among the mountains of the west. He joined the Congregntional church when young, and at the time of his death was a member of the 1st Congrogational church of Salt Lake City. He was married to Rhoda Beard December 6, 1885, and died in Dillon, Montana, December 28, 1901, aged 55 years, 11 months and 28 days and was buried at Salt Lake City. He was a most kind hearted, sympathetic friend, a tender and affectionate husband and father and lived a clean, upright christian life—a life without a stain. Memorial services were held at the home of D. A. Beard, Thursday afternoon, conducted by the Rev. E. M. Vittum.
