Funeral Of Jesse ^{G-4} Rayl Held Thursday

Jesse Macy Rayl, the son of Himel-
ius and Jane Rayl, was born in Powe-
shiek County, Iowa, Feb. 29, 1860, and
departed this life Feb. 21, 1925, at the
age of 64 years, 11 months and 21 days.

He was the fifth son of a family of
ten children. The father, mother, two
brothers and one sister preceded him
to the great beyond. He grew to
young manhood in this neighborhood
and in 1885 went to Kansas where he
resided until his death.
