

Glen Read *H-R February 25, 1982* services held

Funeral services for Glen A. Read, 91, of Brooklyn, who died Saturday, Feb. 20, at Grinnell General Hospital, were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Madison Church of Christ.

The Rev. Dennis Smith officiated, and organist was Marilyn Lang. Pallbearers were Craig Lang, Mike Montgomery, Loren Read, Brian Read, Joe Valdez and Marvin Read. Burial was at the I.O.O.F. Cemetery, Brooklyn, with the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
