Mr. Lucas E. Redfield was born at Troy N.Y., July 14, 1841 and from that time until he reached the age of 21 New York state was his home. At that age he enlisted on Nov. 9, 1863 in the U. S. army with Co. F, and later was transferred to Co. D, of the 7th New York Heavy Artillery Volunteers and was honorably discharged from that service at the close of the war on August 1, 1865. Later he came to Iowa and settled at Iowa City where he was married to Kezia Lioyd on Aug. 12 1882.

Mr. Redfield is a man who has been missed among Grinnell people during his illness of the past few months which has caused him to be bedfast. As a painter he was a man who could always be proud of his work as it was appreciated by the public.

His death was caused by hemorrhage of the brain and attacks of the heart. His life passed out at midnight Saturday May 18. Surviving him are a wife, two sons, two daughters and two brothers, his father and mother both being dead.

The remains were sent to Grinnell and funeral services were conducted by Prof. L. F. Parker from the residence at 2:30 p. m. Tuesday, May 21.

Mr. Redfield was 65 years 10 months and 18 days old.
