Alfred Robinson Reeves was born November 24, 1838 near the little town of Pleasant Hill, Montgomery Co., Indiana, and departed this life at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Arthur Fleener, near Grinnell, Iowa, October 26, 1925 at the age of 86 years 11 months and 2 days.
