Johanna Rehberg, Longtime Resident Of Area, Dies

Johanna H. Rehberg, 89, of Rtc. 3, Grinnell, died Saturday evening at a hospital in Des Moines.

Services are to be held at 2:00 p.m. Tuesday from St. John's Lutheran church with the Rev. Laverne Streich officiating. Interment will be in Ivy Hill cemetery at Malcom with James-Schalinske Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Daughter of Peter and Wiebke Stoldt Hanssen, she was born on June 20, 1875, at Blue Grass. In She attended the schools of that community and when she was 9, her parents moved to Malcom where she completed her education.
