## Kellogg Resident, Mrs. Hugo Reichelt Succumbs Tuesday

Mrs. Hugo (Gloria Susan) Reichelt, 83, a resident of Kellogg since 1907, died early Tuesday morning at a Newton hospital.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Thursday from St. Paul's Lutheran church at Kellogg with the Rev. Kenneth Eggen, pastor, conducting the rites. Interment will be in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.

The daughter of August and Katherine Heimbecker Thon, she was born Nov. 23rd, 1881, in Huron county, Dashwood, Ontario, Canada. She received her education in Canada.

In 1897, she moved from Canada to North Dakota, and on Nov. 26th, 1903, at Langdon, N. D., was united in marriage with Hugo Reichelt. They moved to Kellogg in 1907.

Mrs. Reichelt is survived by a son, Sherman C. Reichelt of Kellogg; a daughter, Mrs. Katherine Schaumburg, also of Kellogg; three grandchildren; three great grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Barbara Ann Ayearst of Detroit, Mich.

Preceding her in death were her parents, her husband in 1962, one grandson, and three brothers.

Mrs. Reichelt was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran church at Kellogg.
