

## Jane Reid rites conducted

Jane Reid, 98, of 610 Main St., Grinnell, died Thursday, Oct. 8, at Friendship Manor.

Graveside services were conducted at 2 p.m. Saturday at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. Sam Reaves, pastor of the Assembly of God Church, officiating. Pallbearers were David Austin, John Austin, Robert Kline, Larry Reams, Ronald Reams and Clair Wells.

The daughter of John Sanders and Ellen Beeler, she was born on Dec. 25, 1888, at the family farm home in Washington Township. She attended rural schools, later graduating from Grinnell High School.
