Donna D. Reynolds, 69, of 1033 Summer St., died Wednesday evening, Jan. 19, at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness.

The daughter of William and Ida Dodge Harris, she was born July 7, 1902, at Grinnell. She attended Grinnell schools and graduated from Grinnell High School. She was married to Jack Reynolds Nov. 10, 1932, at Blue Earth, Minn. Following their marriage, they made their home in the Tri-Cities area.
