Thomas G. Reynolds, 47, of 1913
Belmont Dr. Grinnell, died suddenly at his home Saturday evening of an apparent heart condition. Mr. Reynolds was Controller of General Telephone Companies of the Midwest and had been associated with the General System

for over 20 years.

The son of Roscoe and Hazel Leonard Reynolds, he was born on Oct. 18, 1922, at Weatherby, Mo. He attended public schools at Plattsburg, Mo. and Northwest Missouri State College in Marys ville.

On Nov. 2, 1946, he married DeeEtta Tyer at Troy, Kan. The couple had one son, Thomas Gary Reynolds, 19. now a student at Kemper Military School and College at Booneville, Mo.

Mr. and Mrs. Reyno'ds moved to Grinnell two years after their marriage and had made their home here since. He was a member of the Grinnell United Methodist Church and the Grinnell Lions Club. He was also active in the Boy Scouts, Elks, Jaycees and the Grinnell Pool Commission. He was a board member at the Methodist Church.

Mr. Reynolds is survived by his wife and son; his father and stepmother; a brother, Bill Reynolds of Smithville, Mo.; a sister, Mrs. Glenn (Virginia Lee) McCormick of Plattsburg; and a number of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his mother and a brother, Leonard, who was killed in action with the Marines in Iowa Jima.
