William Reynolds died at his home in west Grinnell at 3 o'clock a.m. March 19, 1903. He was born in Lincolnshire, England, Aug., 31st, 1825, and came to this country in 1850, first residing at Hudson, Summit county, Ohio. In the fall of 1855 he came to Grinnell and continued to live here until the time of his death. Mr. Reynolds was twice married, two children by the first wife surviving their mother, J. A. Reynolds of Odeboldt and Frank Reynolds of this city, a daughter by this marriage having passed away. His second wife was Mrs. Charlotte Elliott before becoming his wife. One child was born to them, Mr. Charles Reynolds of Ft. Dodge. The funeral was conducted from the Baptist church this morning at 10 o'clock by the Rev. S. Rowland Robinson. Those present from out of town were John Reynolds and wife of Odeboldt and Charles Reynolds and wife of Ft. Dodge. Mr. Reynolds will be remembered by the older citizens of the place for his energy and industry. He was a farmer who labored hard and successfully and made friends with those with whom he dealt.
