Irvin M. Rhodes Services Jan. 2

Irvin W. Rhodes, 53, a former Poweshiek County resident, died suddenly Dec. 23 of an apparent heart attack in Sacramento, Calif.

He was born March 8, 1916, in Sheridan Township. He attended rural schools and Gilman high school before entering the U.S. Army at age 18. He completed high school in the Army and also attended two years of college in Lawton, Okla. Mr. Rhodes served in the Army for 23 years. Following his retirement, he worked in civil service.

He is survived by his two sons, Robert of Sacramento and Roy of Oakland, Calif., who is in the U.S. Navy; his mother, Iva Rhodes of Toledo, Iowa; a brother, Wilbur F., also of Toledo; and a sister Katherine Wooten of Tama, Iowa. He was preceded in death by his wife, Myrle Shipley Rhodes, whom he married in 1941, and his father, Wilbur Rhodes.

Funeral services for Mr. Rhodes will be held Friday, Jan. 2, at the Henderson Funeral Home in Toledo. Burial will be in Lawton.
