

Mrs. Robertson rites Nov. 9

Mildred J. Robertson, 90, of the Montezuma Senior Home died Wednesday, Nov. 6, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the Schmidt-Vigen Funeral Home in Keokuk under the direction of the Watts Funeral Home in Montezuma. Burial was in Oakland Cemetery at Keokuk.

The daughter of Clyde R. and Belle Brackett Joy, she was born on Oct. 31, 1895, in Keokuk. She graduated from Keokuk High School and attended the Mt. Vernon Seminary in Washington, D.C.

She was married to Hugh Robertson in 1915. She left Keokuk in 1938 and lived in many communities, including Chicago and New York. While in New York she operated a

business that manufactured equipment for cerebral palsy victims.

Mrs. Robertson was a member of the Keokuk Congregational Church. She was also active in the Iowa Federated Women's Club and had served as a state officer and as conservation chairman. She returned to Iowa in 1980, living at the Presbyterian Home in Ackley and the Senior Home in Montezuma.

Survivors include one daughter, Carol Johnson of Grinnell; one son, Hugh Robertson of Newport Beach, Calif.; eight grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
