

Merle Robinson L-21-
Rites Jan. 15, 1960

Funeral rites for William
Merle Robinson, 55, were
held at 2 p.m. Jan. 15 at
the Steffy Funeral Home,
conducted by the Rev. George
S. Snyder of the Methodist
church. Burial was in
the family lot in Masonic -
L.O.O.F. cemetery.

Merle was a Montezuman,
living with his parents in
the south part of town until
after their death. He then
went to Mt. Pleasant and was
a custodian for Iowa Wesley-
an college at the time of his
death. Death is believed to
have followed being struck
with an automobile Monday
Jan. 11, while crossing a
street. Joseph John Wilson,
rural Mt. Pleasant, identi-
fied as the driver of the car,
said Merle walked into the
left front fender of his car.
The accident was at 5:40
p.m., just a couple of hours
before the city officials were
presented a citation for go-
ing 10 years without a traf-
fic death.
