

Former Resident Of Kellogg Passes

William Robison, 72 years old and a former resident of this place, died at his home in Newton Monday morning. He had been in failing health since 1924. He was born in Illinois June 14, 1860, and came to Iowa with his parents in 1876. In 1888 he was united in marriage with Miss Emma Morgan and they made their home on a farm southeast of town until 1917, when they moved here to live. They moved to Newton in 1925 where they have resided since.

Mr. Robison was a member of the Odd Fellows lodge for thirty-five years.

Surviving relatives include his wife, and two daughters, Mrs. Benton Stahl of Chicago, and Mrs. W. N. Wood of Willshell, Ill.; one brother, A. V. Robison of Grinnell; two sisters, Mrs. R. G. Morgan and Mrs. E. P. Reibert of Des Moines, and three grandchildren, George and John Stahl and Richard Wood.

Funeral services were held from the Christian church at Kellogg Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with Dr. J. Irvine Walker in church. Burial was made in the family lot in Our Silent City.
