HENRY ROHB. Henry Rohr was born on January 5, 1842, in Wittenburg, Stelburgen, Holstein, Germany, and died August 2 1909. He was confirmed at the age of fourteen and has been a member of the German Lutheran church ever since. He came to America in 1866, when he came to Davenport, where he stayed two years. From there he came to Poweshiek county, where he settled down and was married to Whilmina Schroeder on November 15, 1874. To this union eight children were born. One has preceded him to the better world. His widow and seven children are left to mourn the loss of a kind father, and loving husband.

A year ago last spring he with his wife moved to Grinnell, where they have lived up to the time of his death. Mr. Rohr had been ailing for some time, but was not sick enough to be in bed until the Friday before his death. On Sunday noon he became worse. He and his wife took communion Sunday evening and on Monday evening at seven o'clock he passed away to the better world. He was a patient suferer and never complained. He died of ptomain poisoning and hypostetic pneumonia, and was unconscious when the end came.

He was buried in the German Lutheran cemetery on Wednesday afternoon at three o'clock.
