Jennie Roozeboom, 81, of Pella died Saturday, Jan. 9, at St. Francis Manor in Grinnell.

Funeral services were conducted Jan. 13 at the First Reformed Church of Pella, with the Rev. Stephen Veldhuis officiating. Organist was Edith Meppelink, and casket bearers were Matthew Roozeboom, Michael Roozeboom, Paul Steenhoek, Clint Van Zee, Marvin Klein and Lloyd Van Zante.

Following her husband's death in February 1988, Mrs. Roozeboom became a resident of Pella Manor where she lived until December 1997. She then resided at the Mayflower until moving to St. Francis Manor.

She was a member of the First Christian Reformed Church and the church's Joy Society. While living near Leighton, she had belonged to the Sunshine Neighborhood Club.

Surviving are one son, Stan of Pella; three grandchildren; two brothers, John Van Zee and Clarence Van Zee, both of Pella; and two sisters, Regina Steenhoek of Zearing and Edna Van Zee of Pella.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one brother, Cornie Van Zee.
